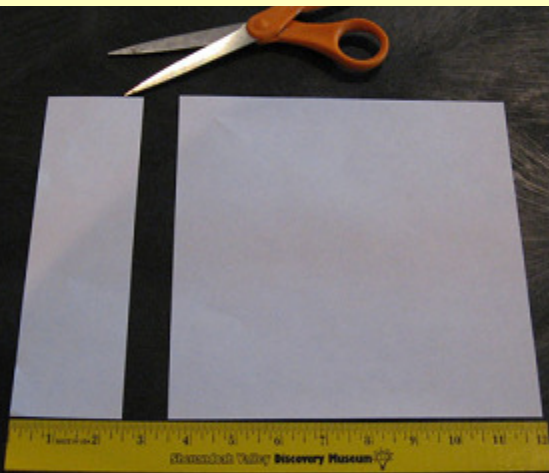
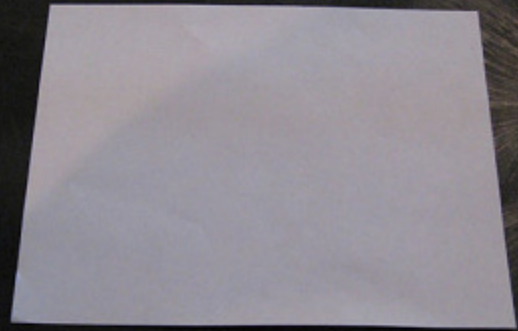


GO FLY A KITE!

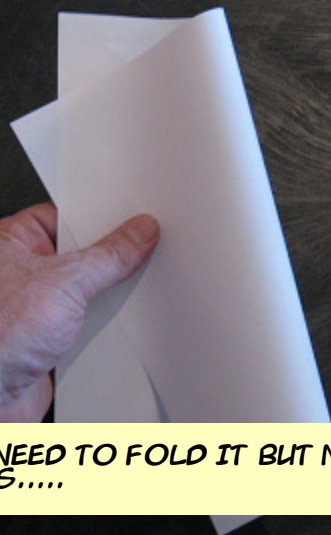

ALTHOUGH IT DOESN'T LOOK IT HERE, WE HAVE A PERFECT SQUARE...

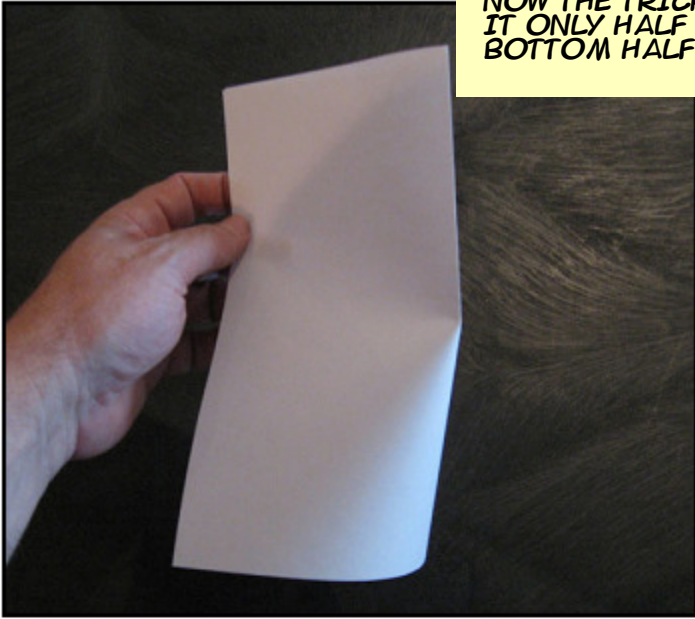


NOW WE NEED TO FOLD IT BUT NOT LIKE THIS.....

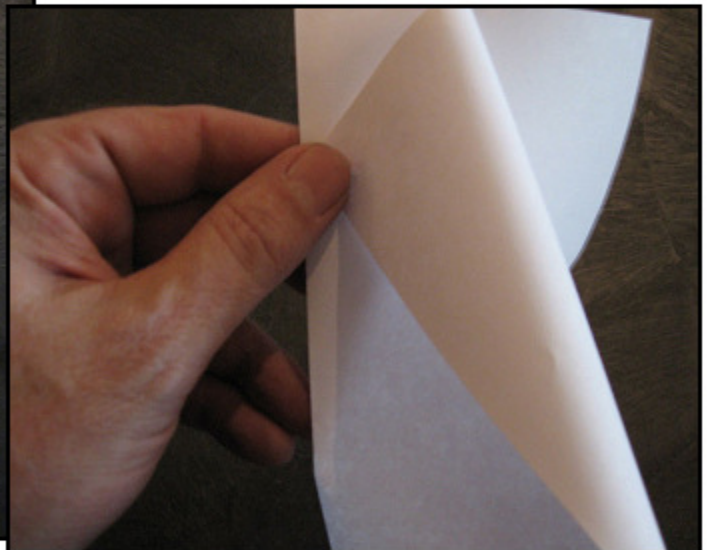
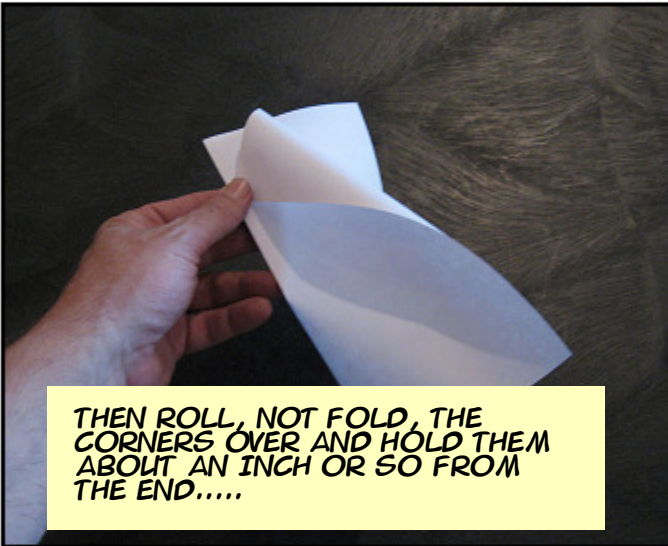
....WE NEED TO FOLD IT NICE AND EVEN SO THE CORNERS MATCH.....



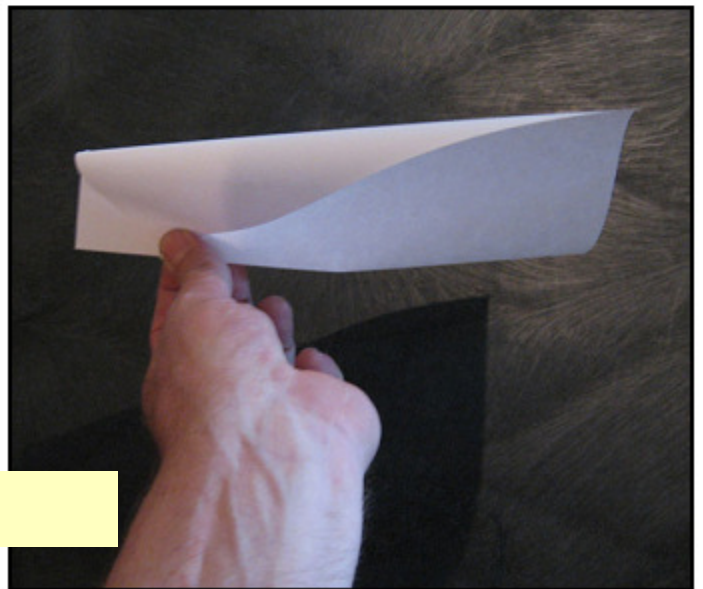
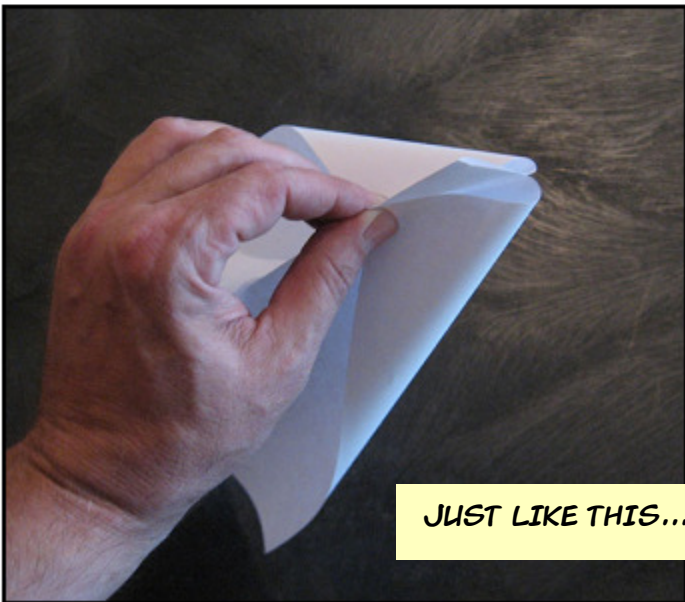
NOW THE TRICKY PART IS CREASING IT ONLY HALF WAY DOWN SO THE BOTTOM HALF STAYS ROUND.....



THEN ROLL, NOT FOLD, THE CORNERS OVER AND HOLD THEM ABOUT AN INCH OR SO FROM THE END.....



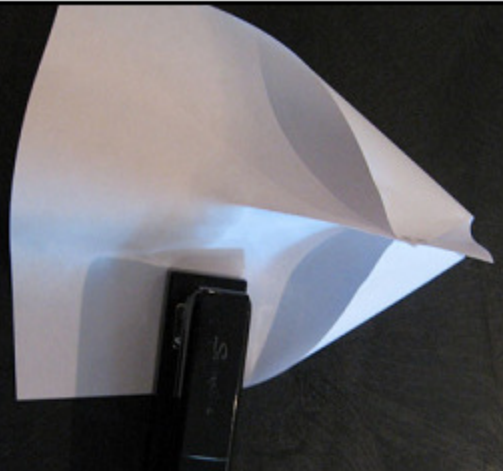
JUST LIKE THIS.....



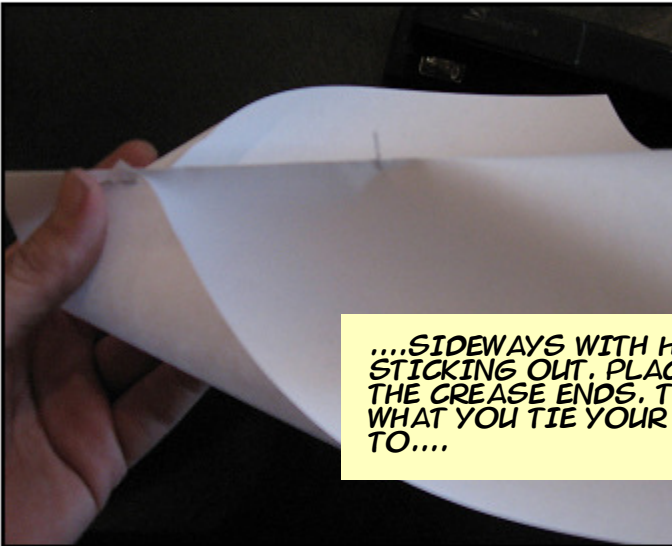
NOW TAKE A STAPLER AND STAPLE THE ROLLED CORNERS TOGETHER THROUGH THE BODY.....



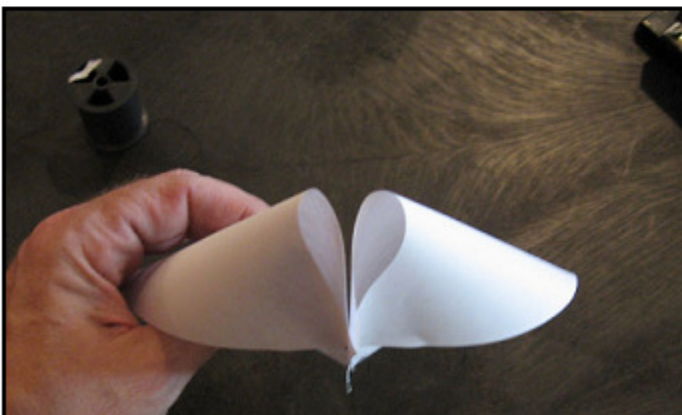
THEN YOU'RE GOING TO PLACE ANOTHER STAPLE IN THE BELLY... ..BUT.....



....SIDWAYS WITH HALF OF IT STICKING OUT. PLACE IT WHERE THE CREASE ENDS. THIS IS WHAT YOU TIE YOUR THREAD TO....



MAKE SURE THE AIR INTAKES, OR 'NOSTRILS' OF YOUR KITE STAY SMOOTH, ROUND AND OPEN. THEN.....
